

Happy New Year VSBC and Fellow Cyclists!

While bike events and formal club rides have been suspended due to the pandemic, it's nice to be able to report that some great bicycle infrastructure projects have been moving ahead in Danville and San Ramon. One project recently completed is the upgrade of bicycle lanes and facilities on Diablo Road between Hartz Avenue on the west end and Green Valley Road at the east end About a

Road at the east end. About a year ago, Danville planners reached out to Mount Diablo Cyclists (MDC) and VSBC to provide input on the plans for this upgrade. With the town's proposed project map in hand, Alan Kalin representing MDC and I (Mark Dedon) visited each proposed bike lane upgrade location and offered our input. The town's planning team was very appreciative and now it's great to see new striping, signs, and bikesensitive signal lights.




New bike box at the intersection of Green Valley Rd & Diablo Rd. in Danville.

Another worthwhile bike safety improvement project is the Diablo Road Trail. As the result of the approval of the Magee Preserve development, a new paved bike trail will be built on the south side of Diablo Road between Green Valley Road and Mount Diablo Scenic Road. Danville planners are finalizing the route for this trail which will provide safe access for cyclists between downtown Danville and the south entrance of Mount Diablo, without the need to enter the private Diablo Road.

Mount Diablo State Park has made progress this year with the installation of four more bike turnouts. This brings the total to 17 bike turnouts in the park. While a total of 77 bike turnouts are needed, it is nice to see some progress with this initiative that is already improving biking safety



and traffic flow. Check out the Mt. Diablo Cyclists website at *https://mountdiablocyclists.org/* for more information.

Finally, San Ramon announced that construction of a long-awaited Iron Horse Trail bridge over Bollinger Canyon Road will begin next year! This bridge will provide huge benefits to cyclists and motor vehicles at one of the busiest intersections in the Tri Valley. For details just search online for "San Ramon Iron Horse Trail Overcrossings Project."

We are fortunate that, during the new lockdowns, cycling is actually encouraged. No official group club rides yet, but at least we can get our cycling fixes solo and look forward to regrouping once the pandemic is conquered by the coming vaccinations.


